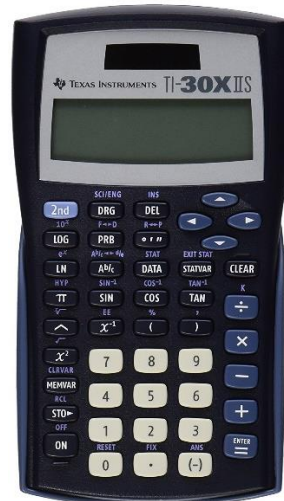
7th-12th Math
